Dimension

Dimension is the name given to lumber that has been cut to standardized sizes of width and height in inches, most commonly used to frame walls, floors, and roofs. Logs are sawn into rough size lumber or cants, then edged and resawn to final dimension and cut to length. Dimensional lumber is used for housing and commercial construction.
