

# Cook County Studs

Studs, traditionally, are 2x4 pieces of lumber used for framing basic buildings in residential construction. They are considered one of the most basic and simple building materials. A stud has nominal dimensions of 2" to 4" thickness and 2" to 4" widths. Studs are separated into three different categories: construction, standard, and utility.
